Entry fees: Per animal 10% of 1<sup>st</sup> Place Premium.

Animals must be in place by 8:30 AM, Saturday, August 18, 2018

**Judging begins at 9:00 AM, Saturday, August 18, 2018**

Animals must meet all Health Requirements as set forth by the NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets.

**ALL Animals Exhibits CLOSE at 8pm on Saturday of the Fair, release time will be determined and communicated by the Animal Superintendent during Fair Week. NO PART OF EXHIBIT IS TO BE REMOVED OR DISESEMBLE UNTIL THIS TIME.**

1. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern.
2. The American Dairy Goat Association has sanctioned the following breeds: Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Toggenburg, A.O.P. (All Other Purebreds) and Recorded Grades.
3. The base for computing ages is August 18, 2018.
4. No substitutions after judging begins. Scratches will forfeit entry fee.
5. Checks payable to the "Wayne County Fair" should be mailed to the Fair Secretary along with the entry forms so as to arrive to the secretary by August 1, 2018.
6. No animal will be allowed to unload without a health check by the veterinarian on duty.
7. There will be no pre-show milk out.
8. The original registration certificate is required for all animals 6 months of age or older, and must be shown to the show secretary before the start of the show.
9. No copies of the registration certificate or stamped application, telegrams or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
10. No horned animals or animals with abscesses are allowed on the grounds.
11. Judging order will be juniors first, followed by milkers of that breed.
12. Group classes will follow each breed. Only does of the breed previously shown will participate in the breed's group classes. **ANIMALS ENTERED IN GROUP CLASSES MUST HAVE BEEN SHOWN IN THEIR REGULAR CLASSES.**
13. **Ribbons awarded to First, Second, Third place. Wayne County Fair rosettes will be awarded to the Junior, Reserve Junior, Senior and Reserve Senior Champion of each breed.**
14. **Premium awards are as follows: 1st....\$13.00 2nd....\$11.00 3rd....\$8.00**
15. Cash premium awards for the group classes will be the same as for individual classes. No premiums will be awarded in classes where no entry fee is charged.
16. The Wayne County Fair assumes no responsibility in case of loss, damage or accident to livestock, person or property from any cause while at the fairground. Entries are received upon this condition only.
17. Junior Does: Purebred, American or Recorded Grades not in milk.
18. Senior Does: Purebred, American or Recorded Grades of any age that have freshened or are in milk (dry milkers).  
**MANDATORY SHOW RING ATTIRE IS EITHER ALL WHITE OR BLACK PANTS WITH WHITE SHIRT**
19. This is not a separately sanctioned senior / junior show.
20. The order of the show is not subject to change.
21. Youth under the age of 18 that are staying on the fairgrounds overnight **MUST** adhere to the "BARN RULES" – Rules are printed in this Fair Book. An adult chaperone is a requirement.

22. Any trailer staying overnight will be parked on the SOUTH EAST CORNER of the fairgrounds in the trailer parking area. Any trailer left over night North of the horse show ring will be moved by fair personal.
23. **No Parking of trucks/trailers around show ring, DUE TO SAFETY CONCERNS. Limited parking will be available on the east side of the livestock barn and space will be available around show tent for pens. There will be a designated area for parking of all livestock trailers. See show attendants upon arrival for direction.**
