RULES: (See rules governing livestock exhibits)

Entries for both Rabbits and Cavies are due Saturday, August 4, 2018.

All animals accepted on SUNDAY ONLY, August 12, 2018 between 1 PM and 6 PM. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Entry fee per rabbit or cavy is 10% of 1st place premium. Payment must accompany entry.

Judging begins Wednesday, August 17, 2018, at 4:00 PM.

Animals must remain on the grounds until 9:00 PM, Saturday, August 18, 2018 and must be picked up no later than 11:00 PM on Saturday, August 18, 2018.

Animals must meet all Health Requirements as sent forth by the NYS Department of Agriculture & Markets. Premium money will be available at the Secretary's Office Friday afternoon.

The superintendent will check the health of all rabbits entered before they are accepted. Any animal that is unsightly or showing signs of sickness or disease will not be allowed on the grounds.

All exhibitors must clearly identify breed, sex, age and color variety on his/her entry blank. Fill out show remark cards.

Show is open to adults and youth (4-H, F.F.A, etc.).

Classes will provide for the following breeds, by sex, with varieties within breeds.

Exhibitors must daily provide feed, bedding and clean full water bottles/containers for their rabbits and cavies.

Exhibitors **MUST** provide their own bedding, feed and feed/water containers.

All entries are entered and shown at the risk of the owners. The Wayne County Fair will not be responsible in case of fire, theft, accident or providential destruction.

Premiums will be paid as follows: 1st: \$5.00 2nd: \$3.00 3rd: \$2.00

Section 1 – 4 Classes: Juniors to be three(3) months of age to six(6) months of age. Seniors to be over six(6) months of age.

Section 2 – 6 Classes: Juniors to be three(3) months of age to six(6) months of age. Intermediates to be six(6) months of age to eight(8) months of age. Seniors to be over eight(8) months of age.

All rabbits must have a permanent tattoo for identification. Tattooing numbers in the ear is permanent and will not disfigure the animal when done properly. It is customary to use the left ear for tattooing.

Cavies will be assigned ear numbers on the day of show and will be placed on tape on the ear for judging

The Wayne County Fair assumes no responsibility in case of loss, damage or accident to livestock, person or property from any cause while at the fairground. Entries are received upon this condition only.

Rabbit and Cavy exhibitors are encouraged to bring in their own fans, as they are NOT supplied by the Wayne County Fair.

Youth under the age of 18 that are staying on the fair grounds overnight **MUST** adhere to the “**BARN RULES**” – Rules are printed in this Fair Book. An adult chaperone is a requirement.
